Established in 1886, the International School of Choueifat (ISC-Choueifat) in Lebanon is celebrating its 130th year of operation with a series of special events throughout the year. The most recent event was a gala staff dinner hosted by Mrs. Leila Saad, the SABIS® group chairperson, and attended by Mr. Ralph Bistany, SABIS® Co-founder.

The dinner, which took place in March 2016, brought together staff members from the SABIS® "Mother School," as it is commonly referred to, as well as directors of SABIS® Network Schools in Lebanon. ISC-Choueifat was established in 1886 as a school for girls in the remote village of Choueifat in Mount Lebanon. Soon after opening, the school became co-educational in response to demand from local families, who wanted the same high-quality education available for their sons.

Drawing on a successful track record and a reputation for academic excellence, the school grew over the years and today enrolls over 1,600 boys and girls from KG1 to Grade 12. ISC-Choueifat graduates are accepted at the best universities in Lebanon and around the world and go on to become conscientious, community-minded individuals who hold prominent positions in both the public and private sectors.
