Two SABIS® Network schools in the U.S., The International School of Minnesota (ISM) and SABIS® International Charter School (SICS), were recently listed on two separate rankings of the best high schools in the U.S. *The Washington Post* listed ISM on its annual “America’s Most Challenging High Schools” list and *U.S. News and World Report* placed SICS on its list of the country’s best high schools.

ISM, a private, Pre-school to Grade 12, college-preparatory, day and boarding school located in Eden Prairie, MN, ranked as the **top private school in Minnesota** in *The Washington Post*’s annual list of “America’s Most Challenging High Schools.” In fact, ISM was the *only* private school in Minnesota to make the list. This is the **fourth consecutive year** that ISM has been recognized for the challenge it offers students.



Joining ISM in having gained national recognition is SICS, a K-12 public charter school located in Springfield, Massachusetts. The school was named among America’s “Best High Schools” by *U.S. News and World Report* after the publication evaluated over 28,000 schools to determine the top ones nationally. SICS serves over 1,500 students in Kindergarten through Grade 12 and has a waiting list of more than 3,000 additional students. This year’s recognition by *U.S. News and World Report* marks the **seventh consecutive year** that the school has been classified among the best high schools and awarded a silver medal.
